1.1. The analogy: directly

An analogy is a comparison between two different things, often highlighting their similarities to clarify, explain, or persuade, moving from the familiar to the unfamiliar. Unlike **simple metaphors**¹ or similes, **analogies provide deeper, logical connections to illustrate complex concepts**².

They are used in writing, reasoning, and problem-solving. [1]

Key Aspects of Analogies:

- **Structure:** They often follow a "target" (complex concept) and "source" (familiar concept) model, often written as "A is to B as C is to D".
- **Types:** They can be **figurative** (comparing unrelated things for insight, e.g., "Life is a roller coaster") or **literal** (comparing similar things, e.g., "The heart is like a pump").
- **Purpose:** They simplify, clarify, and make abstract ideas concrete.

Examples:

- **Structure:** "Branch is to tree as arm is to man".
- **Explanation:** "Just as a sword is the weapon of a warrior, a pen is the weapon of a writer".
- **Figurative:** "Life is like a box of chocolates".

Analogies differ from mere metaphors because they analyze and explain the relationship, rather than just stating a similarity. [1] cf. interaction, semantics, communication achieved notion in Majetic!

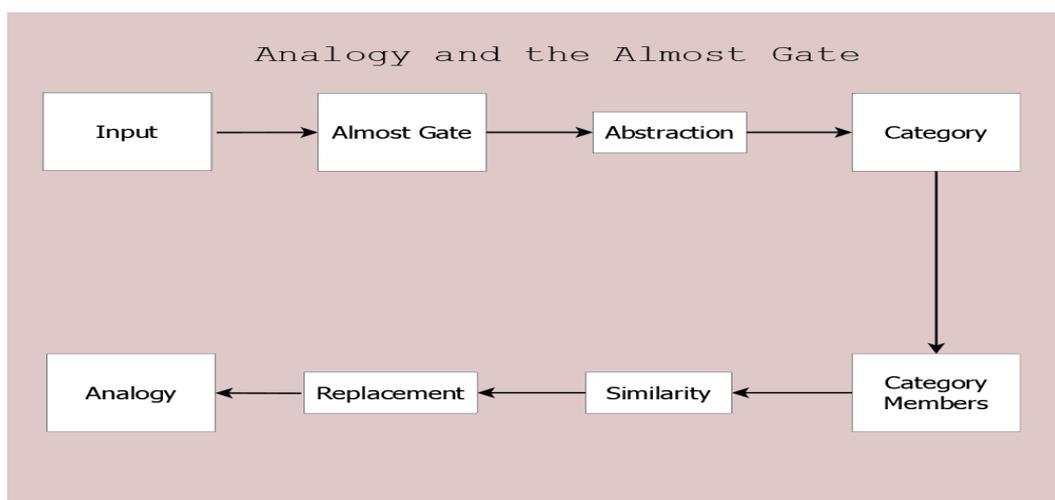


Figure 2: Replacement input analogy ALMOST path Overreacher and Reacher (scheme) [2]

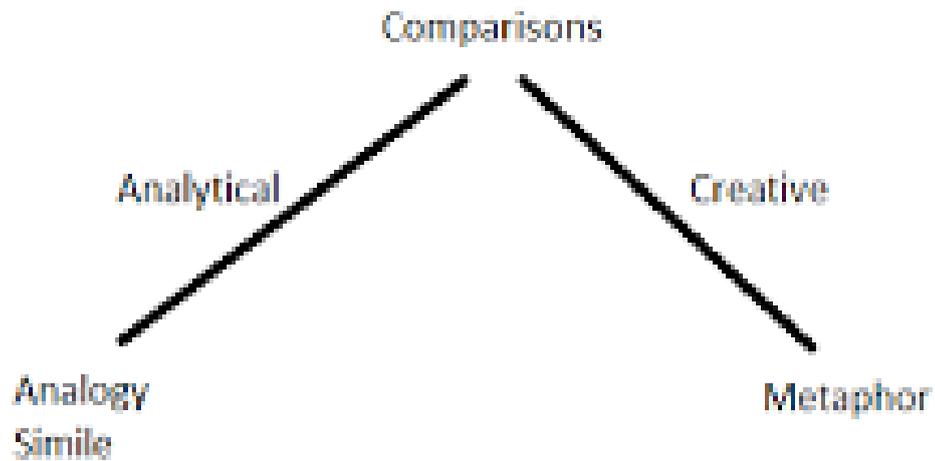


Figure 3: Comparisons (EVOLUTION) Language variation and CHANGE cf. in Majetic [2] 1952 1953 norm form (re)thinking? Now and Then?
